



**Swim Natation Manitoba    Post-Secondary Returning Scholarship**

***\*Academic Year and corresponding Swim Season 2023 - 2024***

1. Description

Two (2) scholarships, in the amount of \$1,500 each, will be awarded to the highest qualifying swimmers enrolled as a full-time student in their second or subsequent years at a Manitoba College or University. This is a one-year scholarship. A swimmer may be selected to receive this scholarship up to four times.

2. Eligibility for the *\* Academic Year* the swimmer must:

- a) Be a resident of Manitoba and member of a SNM registered swim team
- b) Intend to continue competitive swimming while attending a Manitoba College or University
- c) Must be classified as a full-time student in first and second terms of the *\*Academic Year*
- d) Have completed the previous school year with a minimum GPA of 2.5
- e) Meet the current ManSask time standard in at least one event
- f) Compete at the highest level of competition for which they have qualified (i.e., USPORT Championships, Canadian Championship, Western Championships, ManSask Champ)
- g) Maintain a full-time training and competition schedule as available and outlined by their club

### 3. Scholarship Selection Process

The SNM Scholarship Selection Committee consists of the SNM Executive Director and the SNM Scholarship Committee. The committee identifies and verifies all swimmers who have applied and have fulfilled the SNM scholarship eligibility requirements. The committee uses the following process to select two swimmers for the scholarship:

- A. Post-Secondary Returning Scholarship - swimmers application must include the following:
  - a) Application information form - page 4
  - b) Copy of Manitoba College or University previous *\*Academic Year* transcript
  - c) Confirmation of enrollment to a Manitoba College or University the *\*Academic Year*
  - d) Club notarized SCM & LCM results from current season, SCM & LCM results from previous season (i.e., Hy-Tek report)
  - e) Completed application and required documentation received on or before application deadline

Selection Preference will be given to:

- f) Preference will be given to swimmers who compete in both short and long course at the highest level for which they have qualified.
- g) Preference will be given to swimmers that have current USPORT times in Olympic events

Selection Process will follow:

- h) All eligible swimmers will be ranked from highest to lowest based on Canadian ranking for all events based on LCM Canadian ranking from current season and LCM Canadian ranking from previous season
- i) Selection of the two athletes will be done with the Canadian senior ranking of their best event
- j) In the event of a tie, swimmers' second-best event will be added and so on until the tie is broken

In the event there are fewer than two eligible Returning Scholarship swimmers, SNM reserves the right to offer additional Entrance Scholarships, to a maximum of two, to the next highest scoring swimmer(s).

4. Notification of Selection

- a) SNM will notify Post-Secondary Returning Scholarship recipients by July 15, 2023.
- b) At the time of offer, scholarship recipients will be required to sign a Letter of Intent indicating their commitment to continue swimming and attending a Manitoba College or University through the remainder of the \* *Academic Year* and corresponding Swim Season.
- c) All remaining documentations must be submitted

5. Disbursement of Scholarship Funds - Scholarship funds are released in two parts

To receive September payment of the \**Academic Year*, recipients must:

- a) Provide transcript from previous year
- b) Provide September dated Registration History
- c) Maintain full-time student status
- d) Maintain a GPA of 2.5 in previous year
- e) Maintain full-time training and competition schedule as available and outlined by club for the corresponding Swim Season

To receive the January payment of the \* *Academic Year*, recipients must:

- a) Provide transcript from 1<sup>st</sup> term
- b) Provide January dated Registration History
- c) Maintain full-time student status
- d) Maintain a GPA of 2.5 in 1<sup>st</sup> term
- e) Maintain full-time training and competition schedule as available and outlined by club for the corresponding Swim Season

Recipients who withdraw from school, retire from swimming, or non-medical leave, will not receive the second scholarship payment.
